

12 Tips for Painting in Watercolor on Yupo Paper

*A Few Things I've learned
(mostly the hard way)
about painting in watercolor
on Yupo paper.*

1. Handle the paper with care. *Oil from your hands will interfere with paint adhesion.*

2. If you get spots where the paint won't stick, wipe Yupo with a paper towel and try again.

3. Dish soap in various strengths mixed with the pigment offers interesting effects and better paint adhesion.

4. Use thicker pigments. *Paints with white in them tend to stick to the paper better. Gouache also works well.*
